my liver was destroyed by a rare condition known as Wilson's disease. The disease went undetected for so long that by the time I started to recognize symptoms, it was almost too late. With chances of survival not in my favor, I went right to the top of the transplant list. My first transplant was not a perfect match, but critical as my body was shutting down. I had a second transplant four days later. Because two strangers made the decision to donate life, I was able to finish college with honors, go on to lead an active life, marry a wonderful man and start a successful consulting business. I have a truly blessed life. I will forever be grateful to both my donors and their families, as I continue to be overwhelmed by their generosity.
